The Vermont Agency of Natural Resources' Rutland District Stewardship Team is beginning the Long-range Management Planning process for Aitken State Forest. Purchased in 1912, the 918-acre state forest has served as a location for many forms of recreation, firewood, hunting, and timber management activities for over 100 years.

Members of the Rutland District Stewardship Team will present results of natural resource inventories and assessments in an open house format. The meeting will feature individual stations that display resource inventory findings and maps along with educational information. There will be an opportunity at each station for conversation with the stewardship team who are prepared to answer questions and solicit comments about Aitken State Forest.
