The Vermont Agency of Natural Resources' Rutland District Stewardship Team is beginning the Long-range Management Planning process for Blueberry Hill WMA. The 1296 Acre Wildlife Management Area was created in the early 1970's, with most of the land transferred to the Department of Fish and Wildlife by the Agency of Transportation. The three main parcels were originally acquired as part of the construction of Route 4.

Members of the Rutland District Stewardship Team will present results of natural resource inventories and assessments in an open house format. The meeting will feature individual stations that display resource inventory findings and maps along with educational information. There will be an opportunity at each station for conversation with the stewardship team who are prepared to answer questions and solicit comments about Blueberry Hill WMA.
