**The burn ban remains in effect for Bennington and Windham counties ONLY.**

**The burn ban has been lifted for the rest of Vermont effective 3:00 pm today, May 12, 2015.**

### **For All of Vermont except Bennington and Windham Counties:**

Fire danger is **LOW** in all of Vermont except Bennington and Windham counties. Widespread rain showers have soaked most of the state except for southern VT. The wetting rain combined with the progression of greenup has allowed FPR to lift the burn ban for these areas. Permits are required once again for all open burning.

Tomorrow will start to dry out once again with lower Rh and gusty winds. Due to the amount of moisture on the fuels, however it will take a day or so dry out. Fire danger will likely be **MODERATE**.

### **For Bennington and Windham counties:**

Fire danger today is **MODERATE** due to overcast skies, high Rh and light winds. Due to the hazardous condition of the fuels, however, areas in these counties could see higher fire danger where drier air could affect these critically dry fuels.

Tomorrow gusty winds and low Rh could combine with the dry fuels already in place to produce Red Flag conditions. Fire danger will be **HIGH** to **VERY HIGH**.
