

2021 Portable Wooden Skidder Bridge Grant Eligibility Form



This Temporary Wooden Skidder Bridge Grant Program is intended to get more temporary skidder bridges in the hands of loggers and foresters who work in Vermont's Lake Champlain basin. Fill out this form and Return it to the Watershed Forester at the email or address below to be eligible to receive a 20' 3-panel wooden skidder bridge for **Free**. The goal of the program is to provide forest managers with the tools to install and maintain proper temporary stream crossings. The funding for this Program comes from the Lake Champlain Basin Program. Winners will be chosen through a lottery. Priority will be given to loggers and foresters who work in the Champlain Basin.

Applications Due close of business August 3, 2021

Eligibility Requirements: Boxes must be checked to be eligible.

- I am a logging contractor and certify that 51% or more of my income is generated from logging operations; Or
- I am a licensed forester or sawmill procurement staff and certify that I am coordinating an average of ____ logging operations annually.
- I understand that, if selected as a Grant Awardee, I am responsible for the transportation of the bridge from East Montpelier.
- I understand that these bridges are to be used for temporary stream crossings as part of logging operations and not permanently installed. "Temporary installations" are distinguished in the AMPs as stream crossing structures that are in place for less than 18 months.
- I understand that if I am the selected as a Grant Awardee, I will be required to sign a grant agreement that includes a waiver of liability with the State of Vermont before I take possession of the bridge.
- I understand that I will report to the State of Vermont usage of the bridge in the first 12 months after I receive it and that this bridge will be used in the Champlain Basin.
